Dmytro and Anna have three children and are soon to be expecting on more. Originally from the Ukraine, the family arrived in the United States five years ago and currently lives in an over-crowded 2-bedroom apartment with one bathroom.

Dmytro works every day as a driver and Anna is a student at Sierra College where she is studying accounting. When she is not at school, she takes care of their three young children.

"I would like to go to College one day and improve my English" says Dmytro, "But my family needs to eat and my children need clothes and we need to pay the bills."

Anna and Dmytro have been especially amazed by all the volunteers who are helping them build their home and others homes.

"All these people are helping other people for no reason," says Anna, "They are just volunteers. I don't remember all the names, but almost every day

Liudmyla and Volodymyr also have three children and are soon to be expecting one more. They too are originally from the Ukraine.

Says Liudmyla, "We were fighting to escape poverty. I don't like to talk about it because it was so hard and my parents are still there."

Liudmyla recalls praying to God to get she, her husband, and her daughter out of the Ukraine saying, "I asked God, just please get us anywhere. He listened and he gave us a chance."

Now, five years later, the family has settled in to Sacramento. Volodymyr works as a mechanic and is studying to be an electrician. Formerly an architect in Ukraine, Volodymyr still dreams of one day continuing his education and returning to the field, but for now he works to support his family

you meet a new friend. I've met so many new friends. And some of them are not young, but they still work so hard just to help other people!"

"It is very inspiring," said Anna when told that her home would be one of the Build for Unity homes. "This is pulling people together. It's sharing. All of us together, helping to help others. It's like a family."

Says Liudmyla, "I am positive because God gave me a place to live and I am grateful, but I have dreamed from the start that I would one day be able to own my own home. ...I'm just always trying to be a believer and have faith. God puts me in situations where I just climb and keep the faith. And now my dream is here. It's a miracle."
