Habitat for Humanity of Greater Sacramento provides affordable home ownership opportunities to the low and very low-income families of our area, as well as preservation opportunities to our community's vulnerable elderly and Veteran populations.

Our pilot "Rock the Block" event in October of 2018 brought together 250 volunteers and over 50 partners to South Oak Park to help repair 17 homes, plant community gardens, fix fencing at the local Jack Davis Park, and add amenities to the local Fruit Ridge Community Collaborative. Join us as we double our impact in 2019 and repair 20- 30 homes, add more substantial improvements to the neighborhood's community assets, and drive this revitalization forwads!
